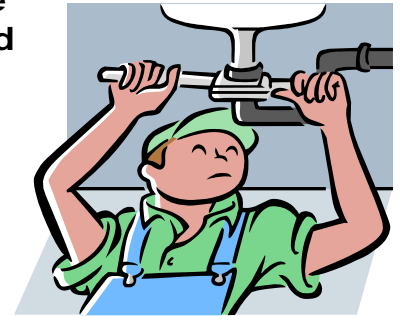

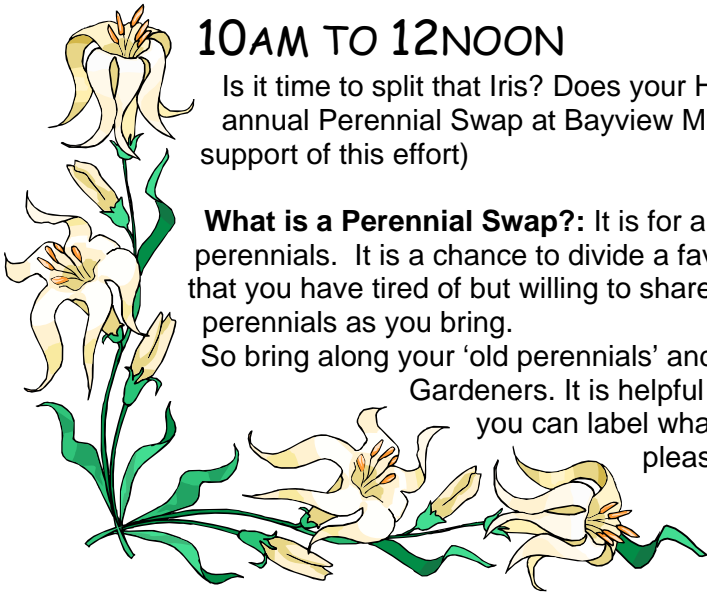
#### REMINDER PERENNIAL SWAP - SATURDAY, MAY 15

**What is a Perennial Swap?:** It is for anyone interested in swapping their bright and beautiful perennials. It is a chance to divide a favourite plant that has grown too large – or to hand-off a plant that you have tired of but willing to share with someone. #### Volunteers Needed

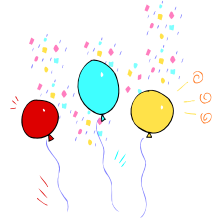
